
Book Recommender Diary and Brochures

Author: Nada Mihelić

This novel describes the life of a young girl who is independent enough to live alone. Her wish to continue living a normal life after a terrible accident (her parents died in a car accident) should be motivation for those who have found themselves in a similar situation.

Title: *The Flowers of Evil*
Author: Charles Baudelaire

Charles Baudelaire (1821-1867) is one of the greatest, if not the greatest poet ever. Baudelaire excels in his expression of a complex sensibility and in modern themes, with intention of causing an abomination in a bourgeois society. He studied and translated Edgar Allan Poe, in whom he found a literary pattern, strongly influencing the development of modern poetry, seeking a new concept of beauty. His most popular book is poem collection *The Flowers of Evil*.

Title: *The Priceless*
Author: Zygmunt Miloszewski

Zygmunt Miloszewski is a Polish writer. *The Priceless* became a bestseller quickly after its release and it brought fame to Miloszewski. The main characters are: Zofia – a clerk dealing with looking for lost masterpieces, Karol – a rich art dealer and paintings collector. Anatolii – a retired commando and Lisa – a famous thief. 
